



INTENSIVE ITALIAN LANGUAGE COURSE CALP - COGNITIVE ACADEMIC LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

OBJECTIVES

The courses, for a total of 60 hours over 3 weeks, are aimed at improving skills in Italian as the language of study for learning subject content (CALP, cognitive academic language proficiency), so that the students can attend lectures and study with adequate Italian L2 knowledge. The aim is to introduce and deepen their knowledge of the Italian language. There are four levels: absolute beginner, beginner, intermediate (A1-B1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for language skills).

CONTENT

- Grammar, language use, language skills necessary for communication according to the European Framework of Reference for Languages
- Reception (reading, listening) and production (writing, speaking) abilities starting from the special variant of the language
- Use of lexical texts (written and spoken) using English for academic purposes
- Authentic communication situations (written and spoken), such as reports, questionnaires, role-play

CALENDAR AND ATTENDANCE

Lessons are held Monday to Friday, 9am-1pm. Minimum attendance is for 3 weeks, 20 hours per week, for a total of 60 hours.

Ist session, JULY: Mon. 4.7 - Fri. 22.7

IInd session, SEPTEMBER: Mon. 5.9 - Fri. 23.9

It is possible to attend both sessions.

Courses will be held with a minimum of 15 students.

On the first Monday of the course, a placement test will be given in order to divide the students into levels.

CANDIDATES

Foreign students, in particular those about to enroll or already registered at an Italian university, for any degree course and area of study.

ENROLLMENT PROCEDURE

1. Complete in CAPITAL LETTERS and send the **Summer School enrollment form** which can be found here: <http://users.unimi.it/calcif/summerschool/>;
2. Send via email to promoitals.calcif@unimi.it:
 - a curriculum vitae in Italian (or English) with an e-mail address
 - a passport-sized photo;
 - a clear scan of an ID document valid for leaving the country, with a photo and legible number.

To apply for a **SCHOLARSHIP** for the second installment also attach:

- Documents, in Italian or English, showing an interest in Italian language and culture, such as certification of Italian language exams taken, participation in seminars or courses in Italian language and culture;

- A letter of recommendation from an Italian language teacher stating the level of knowledge of the Italian language candidate.
- 3. Wait for confirmation of enrollment and proceed to pay the first installment of € 250 following the directions sent by e-mail.
- 4. Wait for further instructions before paying the second installment.

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION PROCEDURE

A committee will award scholarships based on qualification and merit. The committee will meet on 27 May 2016 for the course in July and June 10, 2016 for the course in September. Requests received after these dates will not be considered. The Secretariat will communicate the results of the selections via e-mail the following week.

SCHOLARSHIP ACCEPTANCE AND CONFIRMATION

Acceptance of the scholarship must be confirmed in writing *via e-mail* no later than **June 20, 2016, to avoid losing it.**

In the case of **delay** in beginning the courses, without timely justification for serious reasons, or **withdrawing before the official end** (1 pm on the last Friday of the course), **the scholarship will be revoked and consequently the full payment of the registration fee will be due.**

Students who do not show up on the appointed day and do not communicate within the first three days the reasons for their absence will not be able to apply for a scholarship the following year.

EVALUATION AND CERTIFICATION

An attendance certificate stating the number of hours from CALCIF - Centro d'Ateneo per la Promozione della Lingua e Cultura Italiana G. e C. Feltrinelli dell'Università degli Studi di Milano will be delivered to students upon completion of the course.

CREDITS (E.C.T.S.)

6 CFU/ ECTS, upon request, after passing the final test at a minimum B1 level

TEACHERS

The course will be held by qualified teachers who currently collaborate with the Università degli Studi

LOCATION

The course will be held at the Università degli Studi di Milano (MM Duomo/Missori)

COST (INCLUDING IVA /VAT)

450€ for 3 consecutive weeks of lessons

Divided:

- 250€ first installment (due when the registration is accepted)
- 200€ second installment / scholarship (due by 20.6)

The tuition cannot be returned for any reason.

The lessons must be attended for 3 consecutive weeks.

30 SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AVAILABLE for 200€ each, to cover the second installment. Scholarship students thus must pay the first installment of 250€, personal expenses, lodging, meals, travel expenses.

LODGING

The university offers lodging at their facilities at discounted prices.
